




For information . . .

FGSR – TOTAL Graduate Program Application #'s and Total Enrolment




FGSR – Enrolment in Arts, Science, Commerce





FGSR Enrolment: Domestic and International Students







 As of November 29, 2017 there was 618 Registered Graduate Students at Saint Mary's University. There was also an additional 41 Visiting Graduate Students for the Fall 2017 Semester.







<u>30 days prior the research ethics clearance expiry,</u> <u>do you need to submit an</u> <u>Annual Status Report or End of Study Report?</u>

! Forms can be submitted electronically

Signatures are not required on the electronic forms

Student involvement, to make a request, is not required, nor can requests from students only be accepted- Must be received by the PI
