Applicants should be new and continuing undergraduate students with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and evidence of consistent progress through their program. Preference will be given to academically strong students in their third or fourth year of studies and to students in the Honours program. A demonstrated experience with POLI courses is a requirement.

When applying, please submit your resume, academic transcript, and a brief explanation (150 words) of why you are interested in serving as a TA. Please indicate a course that you would like to be assigned for. Only one TAship can be held per school term. The remuneration amounts to \$660 (30 hours per term, at \$22 per hour, inclusive of vacation pay).
