





**Breadth of Coverage (ICE Factor 6):** The breadth of coverage factor reflects students' responses to items concerning the extent to which the instructor contrasted implications of various theories, provided the background for ideas and concepts, presented different points of view and discussed current developments. Each of these activities involve substantive qualities of instruction. Each has the potential to increase student knowledge and understanding by facilitating generalization beyond the confines of the specific situation, and by clarifying the material to be learned and its meaningfulness to the learner.
